California Children's Hospital Association Issues Statement on Passage of Proposition 4

Sacramento, Calif. (November 6, 2018) – California Children's Hospital Association President and CEO Ann-Louise Kuhns today issued the following statement about the projected passage of Proposition 4, the Children's Hospital Bond Act of 2018:

"California's children's hospitals provide life-saving care to our state's sickest, most vulnerable children. We're grateful to voters for supporting that work by casting their ballots in favor of Proposition 4. These funds will allow our hospitals to upgrade their facilities to meet new seismic safety requirements, update technology and expand capacity so that we can continue to provide the best care and save more lives."

By approving Proposition 4, voters have authorized a \$1.5 billion bond to expand and upgrade California's children's hospitals, which handle more than 2 million visits every year from children and young adults who are suffering from serious and life-threatening diseases. The measure was endorsed by [more than 100 elected officials, organizations and community leaders and by editorial boards across the state](#).

About Proposition 4: The Children's Hospital Bond Act Of 2018

California's 13 regional children's hospitals provide specialized care to treat children and young adults up to age 21 who suffer from serious and life-threatening diseases such as leukemia, sickle cell disease, cancer, and cystic fibrosis. The hospitals handle more than 2 million visits each year, including from some of the state's lowest-income children, regardless of a family's income or ability to pay. The Children's Hospital Bond of 2018 provides \$1.5 billion over 15 years to support this critical, life-saving care.
